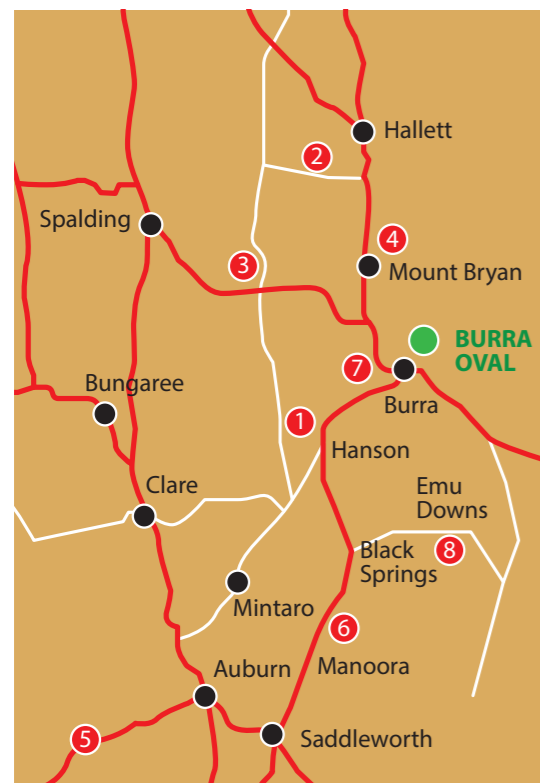




# ELDERS SA STUD

After some challenging seasons, it's great to see wool and meat prices on the rise, putting South Australian dual-purpose Merino producers in a strong position for the year ahead. The Expo has grown into one of the most anticipated events on the Merino calendar, a chance for producers, breeders, advisors and industry partners to connect, share ideas, and showcase the very best of SA Merino breeding and wool production.

This year's program runs across two big days, each offering something special for both commercial growers and stud breeders:

### Wednesday 11 March

Start the day with on-property displays, where you can walk through some of the state's leading studs and see firsthand the management practices behind them. Then join us that evening for the AWI Woolgrowers' Dinner and the AWI & Iris & Wool Fashion Parade from 6pm.

Adding to the excitement is the new Commercial Fleece Competition, celebrating fibre quality and the skill of the growers behind it. Winners will be announced during the dinner.

### Thursday 12 March

Head to the Burra Oval for the centralised display, where studs from across SA will present their top rams and ewes, showcasing genetics that reflect decades of selective breeding and performance-driven progress.

The day also features two major competitions:

- Elders SA Stud Merino Ram of the Year — with a \$6,000 first prize, attracting strong competition from studs statewide.
- Ram and Ewe Pair Competition — recognising balance, structure, and commercial relevance, with a Universal Feeder prize up for grabs.

Alongside these displays, you'll find a wide range of trade and industry exhibits, making this an event not to be missed. It's the perfect opportunity to compare genetics, discuss breeding direction, and connect with operations driving the industry forward.
